



# Protecting yourself from crime and not to be a criminal



## ◎ Be warned for phone calls from an embassy or the Ministry of Public Security.

They may ask for your personal information or money.

If you feel suspicious, hang up the phone call once and talk to your family or friends.



## ◎ Do not gamble illegally

Illegal gambling can get you into debts which may become a cause for you to commit a crime or get involved in a trouble.

## ◎ Selling or buying your bank accounts are a crime

You may find a post on SNS saying “You can get 30,000 JPY if you sell your bank account.”

**It is a crime to sell your bank accounts to others.**

Do not sell your bank accounts to others and close your bank accounts when you return to your country



## ◎ Be cautious for a part-time job with a high pay

There are posts to recruit part timers on SNS saying “your just need to withdraw money,” “you just need to pretend to be someone else and receive a luggage at an apartment” or “you just need to pretend that you lost your residence card.”

**These jobs are all crimes.**

**You will get arrested by the police as an accomplice of fraud.**



If you become a criminal, get arrested and deported, you will not be able to see your family and friends or come to Japan. You must protect yourself.

**Friends, families and the police can protect you.**
